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U.P. PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIP RULES

(Undergraduate)

A. Benefits:

- a. Free tuition fees
- b. Free miscellaneous fees
- c. Free laboratory fees
- d. Monthly stipend:
 - a. Undergraduate P 2,000.00

(Including summer if requires in the curriculum)

- e. Book allowance per semester:
 - a. Undergraduate P 2,000.00

The scholarship does not cover the cost of transportation.

B. Duration:

a. Undergraduate - Normal length of time required to finish the course.

C. Rules:

a. To maintain the scholarship, a recipient must carry the normal load prescribed for the course in which the student is enrolled and must pass all academic subjects every semester with a yearly weighted average of at least "2.0" in the undergraduate. All grades of "4.00" or "Incomplete: must be removed or completed on or before the end of the summer term of the immediately following academis year. Provided, however, that is the case of a recipient in the Intarmed Program, the student must pass all the academic subjects with a yearly weighted average of at least "2.0" from year level III to IV.

b. Scholarship lost due to academic reasons may be recovered provided the student obtains in the semester immediately following the disqualification at least a weighted average of "2.0" (for undergraduate). In case the scholastic deliquency is not due to academic inadequacy, the University Committee on Scholarships and Financial Assistance, after a thorough evaluation of the case, may allow the scholar to retain the scholarship

Reinstatement will be allowed only once.
